

# How to use your Prescription Drug Benefit with a High Deductible/Qualified Health Plan

## HIGH DEDUCTIBLE/QUALIFIED HEALTH PLAN OVERVIEW

High deductible health plans are intended to give you some control over how your healthcare dollars are spent.

- ▶ Most services are subject to your specified individual or family deductible before insurance will provide any benefit.
- ▶ While this can sometimes be challenging, there are ways to use your drug plan to your financial benefit.

## TIPS FOR USING YOUR DRUG PLAN WITH A HIGH DEDUCTIBLE/QUALIFIED HEALTH PLAN

It's important to know what your drug plan covers at no cost to you.

- ▶ Flu shots, pneumonia vaccinations, and shingles vaccinations (age dependent) are all covered at any network pharmacy at no cost to you.
- ▶ Many contraceptives are covered at no cost. Simply present your insurance card at a network pharmacy and the services are covered under your drug benefit.
- ▶ As of January 1, 2018 we cover the following medications at no cost for members age 40-75:
  - ▶ Atorvastatin (Lipitor) 10mg, 20mg | Fluvastatin (Lescol) 20mg, 40mg | Fluvastatin ER (Lescol XL) 80mg | Lovastatin (Mevacor) 10mg, 20mg, 40mg | Lovastatin ER (Altoprev) 20mg, 40mg, 60mg | Pitavastatin (Livalo) 1mg, 2mg, 4mg | Pravastatin (Pravachol) 10mg, 20mg, 40mg, 80mg | Rosuvastatin (Crestor) 5mg, 10mg | Simvastatin (Zocor) 5mg, 10mg, 20mg, 40mg.
