

How to use your Prescription Drug Benefit with an Essential Health Plan

COPAYS

The WEA Trust Essential Health Plan has copays that apply to the specific tier of your medication.

- ▶ WEA Trust provides a list of medications by tier on our website at www.weatrust.com/drugplan.
- ▶ Copays are based on the tier of the medication and the days supply being dispensed.
 - ▶ One copay applies to any medication filled as a 30 day supply or less.
 - ▶ Two copays apply for a 31-60 day supply.
 - ▶ Three copays apply for a 61-90 day supply.

PRESCRIPTION HOME DELIVERY SERVICE

- ▶ You can use our home delivery service for many medications that you take on a regular basis. Visit www.medimpactdirect.com.
 - ▶ Home delivery service has only two copays for a 90 day supply.

NO COST DRUG COVERAGE

It's important to know what your drug plan covers at no cost to you. Simply present your insurance card at a network pharmacy and the services are covered under your drug benefit.

- ▶ Flu shots, pneumonia vaccinations, and shingles vaccinations (age dependent) are all covered at any network pharmacy at no cost.
- ▶ Many contraceptives are covered at no cost.
- ▶ As of January 1, 2018 we cover the following medications at no cost for members age 40-75:
 - ▶ Astorvastation (Lipitor) 10mg, 20mg | Fluvastatin (Lescol) 20mg, 40mg | Fluvasatatin ER (Lescol XL) 80mg | Lovastatin (Mevacor) 10mg, 20mg, 40mg | Lovastatin ER (Altoprev) 20mg, 40mg, 60mg | Pitavastatin (Livalo) 1mg, 2mg, 4mg | Pravastatin (Pravachol) 10mg, 20mg, 40mg, 80mg | Rosuvastatin (Crestor) 5mg, 10mg | Simvastatin (Zocor) 5mg, 10mg, 20mg, 40mg.)
