Coverage	<i>Screening mammogram</i>	<p>Screening mammograms are used as a tool to detect early breast cancer in women experiencing no symptoms.</p> <p>The Affordable Care Act (ACA) requires insurers, including WEA Trust, to pay for in-network annual screening mammograms starting at age 40, with no deductible or coinsurance. This includes coverage for both 3D and standard 2D mammograms. Under your policy, you may have a screening mammogram once every calendar or plan year. Preauthorization is not required.</p> <p>The mammogram must be performed by an in-network provider to be paid in full, with no deductible or coinsurance.</p> <p>Non-network deductible and coinsurance will apply to screening mammograms performed by a non-network provider.</p> <p>Members can search for network providers using Find a Doctor on WEATrust.com by choosing the “Trust Preferred” network options.</p>
	<i>Diagnostic mammogram</i>	<p>Diagnostic mammograms are performed when a patient or their health professional discovers unusual signs or symptoms in one or both breasts.</p> <p>In-network deductible and coinsurance apply diagnostic mammograms are performed by an in-network provider. Non-network deductible and coinsurance apply when performed at a non-network facility. There is no limit on the number of diagnostic mammograms per calendar year if the mammogram is medically necessary. Preauthorization is not required.</p> <p>Members can search for network providers using Find a Doctor on WEATrust.com by choosing the “Trust Preferred” network options.</p>
